TERMS & CONDITIONS

All entrants must have a paid ticket/entry into the racecourse on the day in order to qualify for entry into the competition.

1. **Method of entry:** Upon entering, contestants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Pre-registrations will be made available online prior to the competition and close on Monday 19 June 2024. You must check in at the Fashions on the Field Stage between 10.00am and 11.30am.

The total number of entrants is limited to 50 in each category and will include the first 50 entrants to nominate/register. Terms and conditions are found at www.ipswichturfclub.com.au

2. **Judging criteria:** Entrants will be provided a Fashions on the Field ID number. This ID number must be shown during judging. Entrants will be judged in five categories.

Category 1 – Most Fashionable Local Category 2 – Best Dressed Category 3 – Finest Duo

Judging criteria will be based on seasonal suitability, originality, choice of headwear, accessories, attention to detail, deportment skills and smile, overall presentation, elegance etc. Up to 8 finalists in each category will be selected for the finals.

Entrants in the Most Fashionable Local category must have identification to indicate they reside in the postcodes including 4300, 4301, 4302, 4303, 4304, 4305 and 4306.

Categories are open to all genders.

Prizes: The prize list will be announced shortly.

All prizes are valued inclusive of GST and the Promoter Ipswich Turf Club takes no responsibility for any variation in item values. Any taxes which may be payable as a consequence of a winner receiving the prize are the sole responsibility of that winner. Prizes are non-transferable and may not be redeemed for cash. If the specified prize becomes unavailable due to unforeseen circumstances, the Promoter may substitute a prize of similar nature and/or like or greater value.

- Competition Duration: The competition commences at 12pm Saturday 22 June 2024. See 1 – Method of Entry for closing time of entries. All entrants must attend the preliminary judging commencing at 11am which will be held on the main stage area located in the forecourt near the main entrance on Saturday 22 June 2024 to be eligible for prizes. Judging will not commence until course officials allow such.
- 4. **Eligibility Limitations:** Entrants who miss the preliminary judging will not be eligible for the final judging. Entrants who do not arrive in time for either the preliminary or final judging will be disqualified. Contestants must be at least 18 years of age to enter.

The following persons are ineligible to enter:

- (i) Employees of, or contractors to, the Promoter so far as they are directly associated with this competition.
- (ii) The spouse, de facto spouse, parent, natural or adopted child, and sibling (whether natural or adopted), of such employees and contractors (whether or not they live in the same household).
- (iii) Contestants who have used or attempted to use any more than one name in order to qualify to win any contest run by the promoter except in the case of a legal change of name.

Judging criteria will be based on seasonal suitability, originality, choice of headwear, accessories, attention to detail, deportment skills and smile, overall presentation, elegance etc. All winners must collect their prize on day of the event. Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. All contest winners must avail themselves for a photo if required by the Promoter and acknowledge that the Promoter has the right to utilize publicity photos in any reasonable manner it sees fit without compensation to the client.

- 6. **Prize collection:** All winners must collect their prizes on the day. Gift Card Prizes must be used by the date indicated on the back of the card. Upon request by the Promoter a copy of the general contest rules and/or a signed receipt and acknowledgement must be signed and endorsed by the winner to understand his/her understanding and acceptance of those terms.
